



Dermot McMeekin: Chairman of Governors.

Dermot McMeekin was appointed as Chairman of Governors at Westonbirt School and Rose Hill Westonbirt in March 2010. His early career was as a Solicitor in Trowers & Hamlins working in Lincoln's Inn & Bahrain.

Mr. McMeekin left the world of law in 1980 to attend Harvard Business School where he obtained an MBA in 1982, subsequently joining the US management consultancy Arthur D. Little and working in Boston, Saudi Arabia and Singapore. He joined Andersen Consulting (now Accenture) in 1993 as Managing Partner of their Asia Strategy Practice based in Singapore.

After retiring from Accenture in 2004, Dermot returned to England and now lives just outside Tetbury. He is Chairman of PMC Treasury Ltd, a financial boutique working primarily with the private equity sector, and is a Non-Executive Director with the NHS in Gloucestershire. Dermot is also a Governor at St. Clare's International College in Oxford.

Dermot has been married to his wife, Pam, for thirty years and has four children, all of whom went to boarding schools with an ethos similar to Westonbirt and Rose Hill Westonbirt Schools.
